1. Grand Rapids, service project, pad project
2. Pontiac/N. Oakland, service project, change of clothes provided to rape victims who's own clothes are taken for evidence by police
3. Flint 2, fundraiser, bus trip to "Menopause the Musical". Domestic violence organization was able to convince Menopause people to support, now come to town, raised \$150K for domestic violence. Bus trip was cost prohibitive for Saginaw club.
4. Flint 1, fundraising project, dance studio performance with "dancing with the stars" theme. Dancing community looks for venues. Held at Baker College. Performance and now dance floor for dancers. Hors'dourves. Mini lessons. Growing popularity. \$3800 profit. Sponsors help defray costs.
5. Fenton, service project, safetytown support for grade school. Sponsors for parts of the town. Kids get helmets. Female police officer, water safety, stranger safety, bus safety. Graduation. Teenagers act as guides.
6. Owosso, fundraising for scholarship, December meeting invites potential members and members bring 2-3 items for live auction. \$800-\$1000 per night.
7. Bay City, service project, head coverings for cancer patients. Members that can't sew can cut fabric, deliver.
8. Southfield, fundraising projects: sell Koeze nuts. Now ask Koeze to donate for Glass Slipper Ball. Theater party in June to honor scholarship recipients..food beforehand. Show movie that is current. Door prizes. Sell admission tickets \$35 on movie day. Slipper Ball tickets \$85.
9. Lapeer, fundraising. Fantasy forest, businesses to sponsor food or booth for mile long trick or treating. \$3 admission tickets.
10. Flint 2, fundraising, Real Benefit benefit for June 31st (nonexistent day) and invite everyone to stay home. Donate to club in lieu. \$2000-\$3000 net. Invitations donated. Invitation list to anyone the club knew that had previously donated or just knew. Include personal note.
11. Saginaw, fundraising, raffle tickets \$20 each and only sold 200 tickets.
12. Midland, fundraising, Christmas homewalk. Local decorators and florists decorate residences for public admission. Runs 2 days. Members serve as hostesses in the homes. Admission cost \$\$15/ticket. Proceeds \$20-\$25K. Every member must sell 6 tickets or purchase them.
13. Midland, fundraising, Loons minor league baseball suite purchased. Tickets \$5 and raffled off.
